Operating revenues include bhandar income from general donations, Shrimad donations, rental income, sponsorship of programs and events such as bhavna, bhakti and namokar jaap, sadharmik vatsalya donations, pathshala fees, membership fees, bank interest income and funds raised through Dollar A Day program.

Dev Dravya and Jiv Daya bhandar income as well as income from sapana ceremony, sponsorship of aungi, shanti kalash, aarti and puja, which totaled **\$18,847** during the first three months of 2002, is excluded from the operating revenues figure above because they are not available to fund Bhawan's operations and maintenance expenses.

Operating expenses include interest on Bhawan loan, insurance, scholar's travel, caretaker compensation and benefits, building maintenance services and supplies, gas and electric utilities, waste removal, telephone, pathshala, landscaping, alarm monitoring, bank charges, sadharmik vatsalya and newsletter printing and postage.

Operating revenues should exceed operating expenses every month. Please continue to support Your Bhawan with your generous donations.

During the first three months of 2002, we received **ONLY \$1,761** in membership fees from **4** new Life members and **7** Annual members. Please pay your annual membership dues promptly. Jain Pilgrimage – a picturesque experience



During our Mahavir Janma Kalyanak Program on Saturday, April 27, 2002, JCNC also hosted an exhibition of Jain Art titled “Jain Pilgrimage – a picturesque experience” at the Jain Bhawan. Milpitas Mayor Henry Manayan was the Guest of Honor and performed the official opening. The Mayor was accompanied by Milpitas City Councilors Jose Esteves and Dipka Lalwani.

The Art Exhibition was presented by Mahendra Visaria, a well known photographer from Mumbai, India.

Jain Art in Jain Temples and shrines dates back to 3 centuries B.C. Examples of this art can be found in Southern India’s cave temples dating back from the 3rd century to the 9th century. Beautiful carvings of Jain



Deities, Temples and Shrines carved in natural granite rocks are visible at Ellora caves, Moodbidri, Badami, Cuddapah, Halebidu, Hoysala, etc. The finer carving Jain art started from 11th century A.D. on stones and marble in western India. These are visible at Delwada, Palitana, Ranakpur, Taranga, etc.

About 120 pictures of Jain Temples from throughout India were displayed. The pictures illustrated the temples’ inside and outside carvings made on stones and marbles and the light and shade effect gave them a 3 dimensional quality.

PROPOSED NEW ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE FOR JCNC

4. Do not offer any Chundaris (Clothes) on any Devis
5. No leather articles on the second floor
6. Please leave your footwear in the Shoes room on the first floor
7. No food, No feeding, No milk bottles on the second floor
8. No offerings to Shri Namokär Mahä Mantra Shilä, three Chitrapats and Pratimäji of Shrimad Räjchandraji
9. Do not enter Gabhära without proper Pujä clothes
10. Please put all money offerings in Bhandär directly by yourself.
11. Observe peace all the time on the second floor
12. No socialization on the second floor
13. Please recite stavans, mantras, shloks mentally when there is another program in progress
14. You are also a volunteer and please help keep our Bhawan clean
15. Do not increase our work, help reduce our work

JCNC Religious Committee Report

Jin Darshan, Jin Pooja, Jin Stuti/Bhaki are the Temple sevak's group work and help to shed the bad Karmas and help to acquire good Karmas.

JCNC Religious Committee & its sevak's group is involved in ongoing operational activities of the Jain Center. These sevaks are dedicated, involved, committed and provide full support to the Temple activities.

The Religious Committee consisting of Pramod Patel, Dipa Doshi, Ashok Domadia, Kaishal Dalal, Himat Dagli, Ashok Sethi, Kirit Bavishi and Navin Dedhia plans, coordinates and administers events and the day-to-day Temple activities.

From the time when we did not have a Poojari/Care-taker at the Temple, the Sevak's group has stepped forward and taken on the task of performing daily activities in the Temple Area. Sevak's group comes in the morning at 7:00 am and some of them stay until the temple close time in the morning. Again, the sevaks come in the evening at 6:30 pm and stay until 9:00 pm to close the doors.

The Sevak's group also assists in performing big event Poojas during Mahavira Jayanti, Temple Anniversary Day, Paryushan and Mahavir Nirvan. Other big events like shibir with Jain Scholar visits are also arranged to provide Dharma Laabh to the community.

Bhavana, Navakar Mantra Jaap and Bhaktamar Stotra recitation activities are scheduled every month. Community members are encouraged to sing Stutis, Stavans or Bhakti Geet during the Bhavanas. Twice a year sponsoring Ayambil Oli and serving Ayambil Tapasvis requires a great effort on the sevak's part. Datta and Girish Shah have been sponsoring these Ayambil Oli since the opening of the Jain Bhavan in 2000. Many of the community members did nine days of Ayambil Oli. During April 2002, about +20 Tapasavis took part in Aymabil every day and 35 Tapsavis during weekends. All 20+ Tapsavis were coming early morning and doing Ayambil Oli's Vidhi and helped in cooking, cleaning, with flawless support to each other. 19+ tapsavis completed all nine days of Ayambil oli. Total 187+ ayambils were completed during the nine days of Ayambil Oli. They were a very devoted and generous group!!!



Datta and Girish Shah have also sponsored Chaudash Ekasanas since 2000. 22+ community members take Dharma Laabh of Ekasanas on every Chaudash. Members come early morning, do their chaudash vidhi and work together in the kitchen. Great support!!!
